On **the 12th of August 2022**, at the Immigration Museum, we present a youth festival for students, schools, and young people to learn a variety of important subjects, causes and issues.

**Focusing on science, technology, arts and culture, personal development and wellbeing, business, and social enterprise.**

The aim of this event is to offer a wide range of skill-building workshops, exhibitors, and speakers offering exciting potential for improving mental, emotional, and physical health and wellbeing, increasing creativity and fulfilment, opening pathways for social enterprise, and improving employment prospects and creative regenerative futures.

This festival aims to provide students with a range of **activities that blend with the school curriculum**, while also helping students learn about **ethical futures, and learning regenerative ways to help improve our future, whether through business, art, culture and technology**.

The re-generation school program will run as morning and afternoon sessions, so schools can choose which session they wish to participate in. Note: it is the same content for both morning and afternoon sessions.

Capacity is 300 people per session, including teachers - numbers are limited and therefore we encourage you to book early. Initial booking is required with a total number of students and teachers.

Closer to the festival, we will send you further communication to determine the session that students wish to book, as pre-booking preferred workshops will be required to ensure places are reserved for your students.
